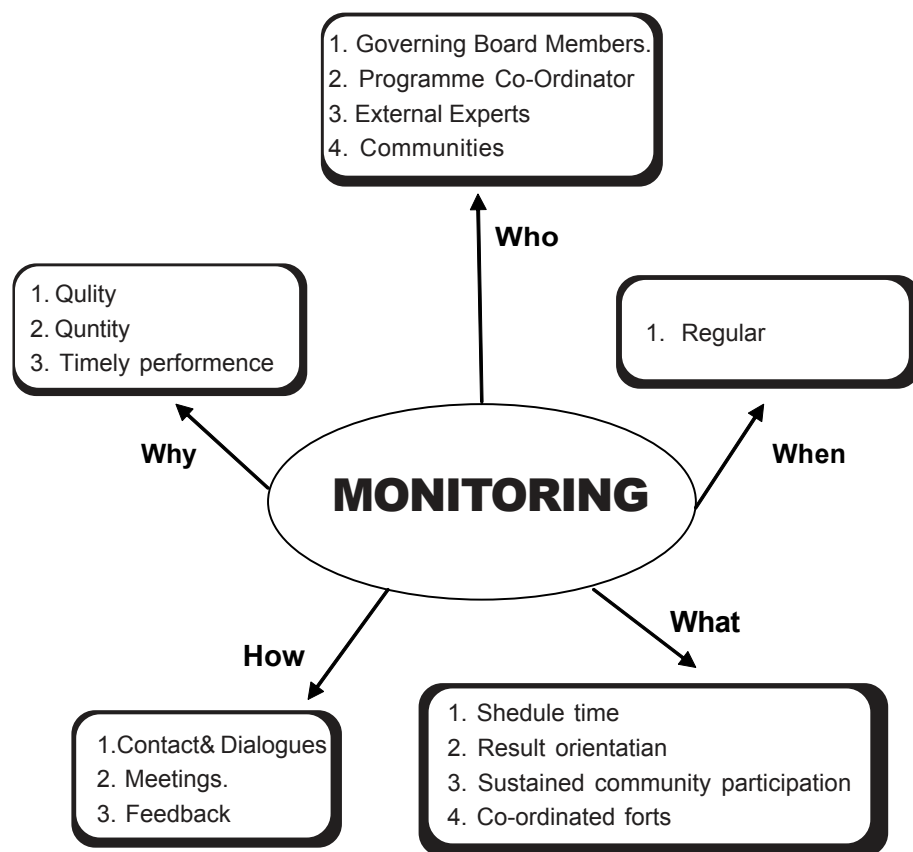




MONITORING MECHANISM

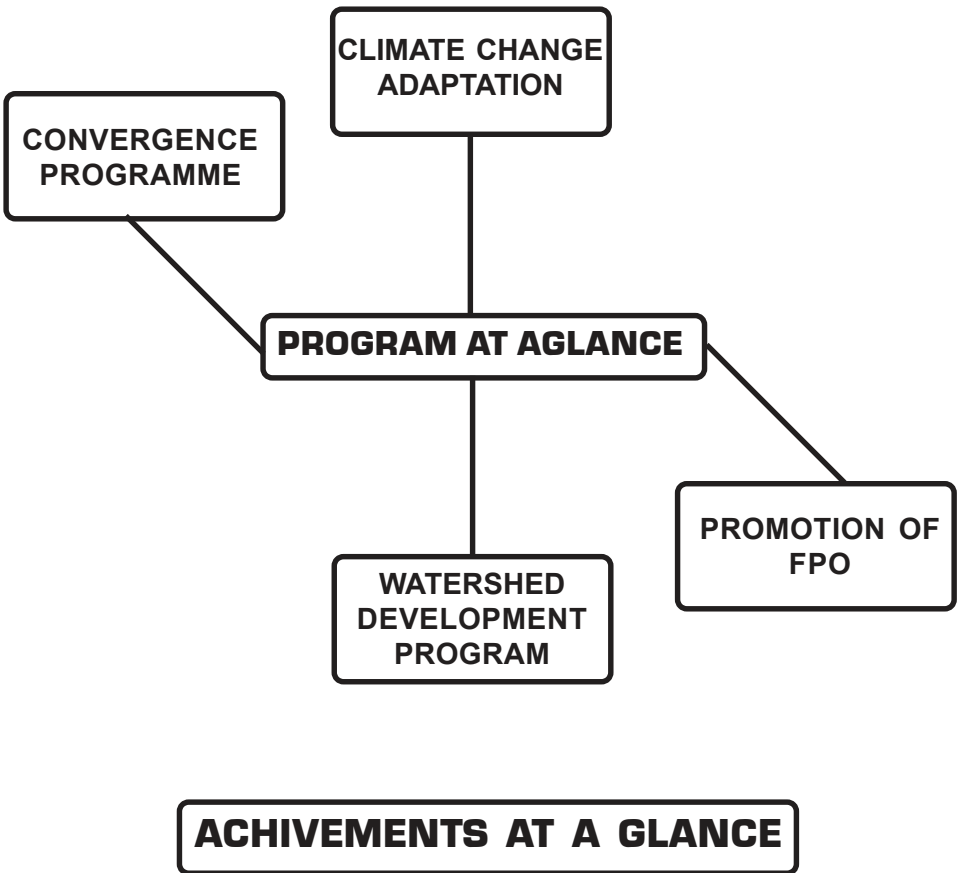

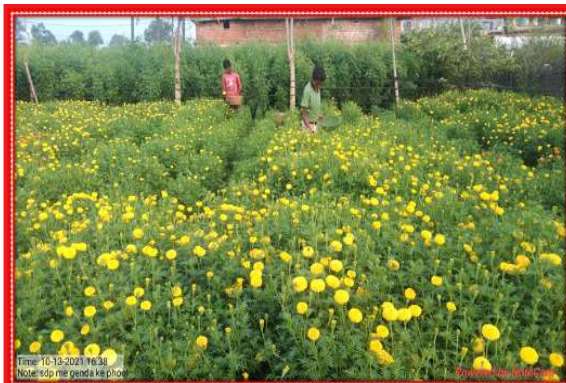

FARMERS GETTING FRAGRANT FROM FLORICULTURE.....

Flowers give fragrance as well as regular communication of enthusiasm in life. With the commercial cultivation of flowers that make the environment smell their fragrance, now the life of the farmers has started to smell. NABARD and Magadh Vikas Bharti and the hard work of the farmers have created a new success story as well as an example for the farmers of the entire Nakteya

watershed area. Commercially, floriculture has fascinated not only the farmers of the neighboring villages of Masondha, Bedauli, Inborwa, Domchuan, Garvaiya but also the neighboring villages of Nakteya watershed area. Farmers have also got

employment opportunity. Rajkumar Yadav, father of both Sukhdev Yadav and Shyamdev Yadav, a farmer of Masoundha village of Kharanti Panchayat falling in Dobhi block area of Gaya district, took the

risk in the initial phase with a view to earn more profit in minimum cost and hard work, taking 4 Kattha of marigold in the land. Cultivated flowers. Before planting flowers, mixed organic manure and chemical fertilizers in small quantities, plowed the fields and made kiriyas. Then got 4000 flower plants from Kolkata in West Bengal. Under the guidance of Yadunandan Kumar, treasurer of Nakteya Jalchhajan Samiti, the sapling was planted on 21 July 2021. A total of 1 4000 saplings were ordered at the rate of one rupees per plant. It took about three months to get ready. Flowering started from September 2021, which ended by December 2021. During this period, a total of 8 quintals of 16 kg flowers were sold in the market from minimum 1 35 to maximum 1 90 kg. It cost about 1 7000 to cultivate and net profit of 1 22,254. The specialty was that in the full season i.e. festival festival like Vishwakarma Puja to Diwali came out between Chhath Puja. Meanwhile, the farmers told that due to lack of information, the plant was found expensive by the trader and there was no technical knowledge of planting saplings. Other farmers of the area were inspired by this and decided to cultivate in abundance in the next season.



SUCCESS STORY

Farmers moving towards modern agriculture leaving behind traditional agriculture.....

The nature of agriculture has changed in the 21st century. The result of this is that today, the loss-making farming is increasing towards profit, the credit goes to the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), which is dedicated to the development of modern farming by going to the village, with the help of this, the farmers in the agriculture sector. Are making progress. One of them is such a farmer whose name is Sukhdev Yadav and Shyamdev Yadav who have studied till ninth class respectively. Both of them are residents of Masaundha village of Dobhi block of Gaya district which falls in Nakteya watershed area. They are counted among progressive farmers. They mainly cultivated paddy, wheat and vegetables. Under crop diversification, they turned to more profitable farming in less time and less cost. Along with this, by visiting places like Ranchi Hazaribagh of harkhand and Krishi Vigyan Kendras, AATMA, of Bihar, etc., got nformation about modern farming, then went to many places and took stock of flower seeds and market. After this, he reached this point of success by cultivating vegetable mustard, Rai, pulses.



Started floriculture in the year 2021. Vermin compost is used in floriculture. Chemical fertilizers were used only when necessary, on the advice of agricultural experts. In the initial phase, he planted 4000 marigold flowers on July 21, 2021 in 4 katthas. This plant was procured through Magadh FPO, Barachatti, Gaya. Purchased at the rate of 1 1 per plant. It took about 3 months for the flowers to be ready. The cost of cultivation was about 1 7000. This flower was sold in the market at the rate of Rs 35-90 per kg. More than 8 quintals of flower were produced and marketed during this period. There was a net profit of only Rs 22754 from flower.

SUCCESS STORY

Growing Farmer Producer Company.....

Magadh Agriculture Farmers Producer is a limited company. It is a body corporate under the Farmer Producer Organization Development Fund of the Government of India. Who is doing her business by registering on 9th February 2016. It is registered under the terms and conditions of the Companies Act 2013. Whose registration number is U01400BR2016PTC025939. The board of directors of the company consists of 6 members including a woman. Company’s Vision “Platform to bring happiness to farmers and villagers in a transparent manner”

The objective of the company - to ensure better income to the farmers engaged in agricultural and non-agricultural products of their area. Take advantage of the economics of working on a large scale. To get rid of touts in the field of agricultural marketing. To bring transparency in working practices and to negotiate well with wholesale buyers and suppliers of the product. The company’s CEO





SUCCESS STORY

Basanti Devi is increasing her income by crop diversification.

Ranjit Prasad Kesari says that the company currently has 1208 members and shareholders. The company's own share capital is ₹ 1000000. With which the company is doing its business. The company does business according to each season and season. The company has procured and sold 9 tonnes of wheat last year only in the wheat season. Apart from this, work has been done to buy paddy and transport it directly to the rice mill. The company has made available fertilizers, seeds and pesticides to the farmers at a subsidized rate. The company has all its licenses for sale of fertilizers, seeds, pesticides. The company is working in association with NABARD, SFAC, IFFCO, BIRD, AATMA, Krishi Vigyan Kendra as well as the countryside. Today the company is moving towards its destination and all the credit goes to NABARD. Since NABARD has done the work of augmentation



under the Promotion Grant Program of its Farmer Producer Organization. Along with this, the constant guidance and support of Poppy Magadha Vikas Bharti is included.

There is already a keen interest of farmers in fruit production in the entire country. In the past, farmers used to produce fruits to meet their needs, but gradually with the inclusion of new technologies in fruit production, today we are moving towards business production. Improved varieties in fruit production, drip irrigation method, balanced nutrient use and integrated pest management in plant protection are increasing the production significant

Similar work is being done in a mango orchard in half a bigha of land by Mrs. Basanti Devi, husband of Shivanandan Yadav, aged 56 years, in village Bela under the Jingura Climate Change Project of Barachatti block of Gaya district, through drip irrigation, in which a total of 21 trees are being produced. Every year, almost all the trees are engaged and are earning a total income of Rs 30 to 35 thousand in every season. Basanti Devi says that our situation is very

good today, although earlier we used to grow maize, arhar etc. in this field but we did not earn that much. It used to be possible, but ever since we have got mango trees from the Jingura Watershed Project, we are earning vph every year and because of the good quality, we also get good prices. Here we never



used to grow lemons but now Here lemon, pomegranate, papaya etc. are produced. Basanti Devi also tells that earlier when there was no work, they used to spend the day sitting, but now when they do not get work, they work in their garden and due to lack of money. But we compensate by selling fruits. Today our children are also happy and they also work with us because they also get two paisa today. Earlier they used to go out to earn but now they work with us in the garden. Today my whole family lives together happily.



KFW SOIL PROJECT SEWOH PHASE-III

INCOME INCREASED FROM DROUGHT RESIST MAP/CLIMBER SEEDS DIBILING (LATIDAR) VEGETABLES

Location :- Village:- Jaigeer and Gowaria, Block :- Barachatti, District- Gaya (Bihar)

Project Facilitation Agency :- Magadh Vikas Bharti

Problem Description :

Bhoktadih is a Dalit dominated area. Most of the farmers here are illiterate. They are not knowledgeable in the matter of modern agriculture. Farmers generally do not take cash crops and vegetables and also have limited exposure to improved farming practices, which also leads to reduction in production and productivity.

Interference :-

After the successful implementation of the Jaigeer watershed project, it was decided to cultivate cash crops, in which it was decided to grow different types of vegetables with green vines. Under Green Fencing Vegetable, 50 selected farmers for the purpose of Bitter Gourd, Prawn, Paror, Cucumber ,BodiFarsbean etc. improved varieties of seeds and insecticides were provided. Along with this, training and Exposure were made to them on topics like preparing nursery, method of transplanting plants, and protection from insects and multi-level cultivation of vegetables etc. Necessary resources were made available to the farmers for getting the construction of vermin compost and vermin wash done. Work was also done by the workers to help these farmers technically as per their need.

Influence :-

- ★ Due to the production of vegetables, the farmers started getting nutritious vegetables.
- ★ The demand for these vegetables increased in the market.
- ★ The farmers started getting cash income.
- ★ There was a huge reduction in the need to buy vegetables from the market to eat at home.
- ★ Alternate crops became a means of production.
- ★ Promotion of vermin composting and a decline in the use of chemical fertilizers.
- ★ Safe disposal of garbage started.





KFW SOIL PROJECT SEWOH PHASE-III

Sukhwadah E.N.B. brings happiness to farmer

Location :- Village:- Jaigeer and Gowaria, Block :-
Barachatti, District- Gaya (Bihar)

Project Facilitation Agency :- Magadh Vikas Bharti

Problem Description :-

Sukhvadah is a rivulet, which originates from the Mahavar mountain and joins the Gokhula river. Due to the slope of the mountain, the rain water was flowing in vain. The land around the drain was suitable for cultivation but due to lack of means of



irrigation Hundreds of acres of land used to be left fallow, the fertility of the land was also slowly getting depleted, the villagers made the organization aware of this problem.

Interference :-

Magadh Vikas Bharti inspired the villagers to build a ENB to stop the water in Sukhvadah Nala with the initiative, participation and cooperation of **NABARD** to solve this problem through a meeting. The villagers were asked to do 4 days of labor. Gaya in which

people got ready and for 4 consecutive days' men and women did Shramdan for ENB. The construction of the ENB took a total of 545 man-days. With the technical help of the organization and the financial support of

NABARD, the Sukhwadah ENB was built on the Nala at a cost of Rs.122878. This ENB was completed in 25 days, due to which there was an atmosphere of happiness among the villagers and they started farming in the surrounding fallow land.



Influence :-

- ★ 100 percent accumulation of rain water started.
- ★ Decreased soil erosion. Climate adaptation is being cultivated in the fallow land.
- ★ The production of crops started increasing 60 acres.
- ★ Employment opportunities increased.
- ★ There is an increase in the water level.
- ★ 53 families are benefiting from this sewerage.

CLIMATE CHANGE & WATERSHED PROJECT

Vermin-wash effect

Problem Description :-

The farmers of Jaigeer village do rain dependent farming due to the irregularity of monsoon. The small and marginal farmers were not even getting the amount invested on the cost of cultivation of the crop. One of these farmers is Dinesh Singh Bhokta,

a poor and marginal farmer from Jaigeer watershed area of Barachatti block of Gaya district of Bihar. He owns about 1.5 acres of land. Before participating in the KFW SOIL project he was cultivating paddy and vegetables in the traditional

way but it was never an attractive task for him due to high expenditure on medicines like chemical fertilisers, insecticides, which were often compensated by less crop. It was not done with low income due to the production of.

Interference :-

Considering the problems of the area, Magadh Vikas Bharati recommended organic farming with vegetables. The project involved the adoption of new practices of vegetable cultivation and crop



planning. It was believed that the cultivation of low-cost and high-quality crops would lead to a strategic change. Dinesh Singh Bhokta, a marginal farmer, agreed to grow the crop in one acre. For this PFA provided one unit vermi wash installation material to the farmer.

, He diligently participated in all the training

sessions like INM, IPM, various composting techniques, different methods/techniques of organic farming, advanced techniques of organic farming and exposure as per project norms. He consulted VWC to

increase his crop production. The cultivation of vegetables also made it possible to provide nutritious food to their family members especially children and women. He now confidently supports his family and himself. It also became possible to increase the additional value.



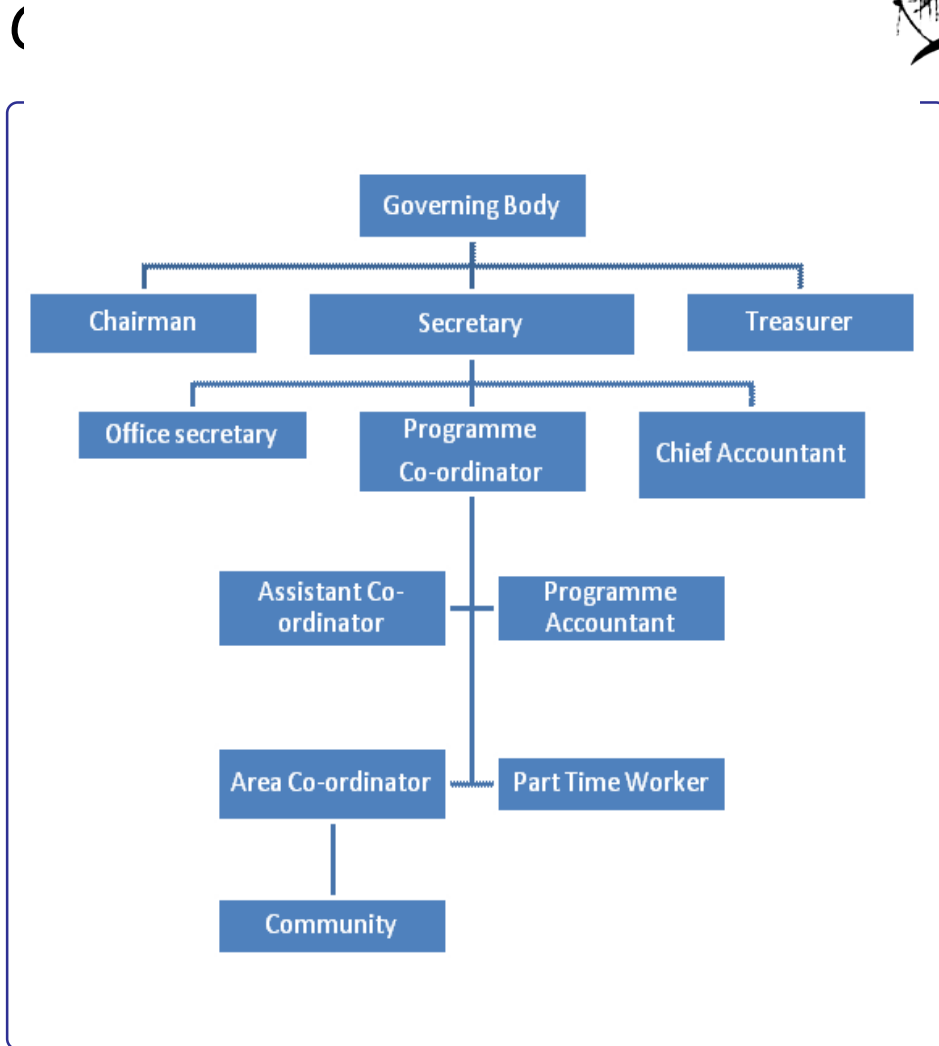


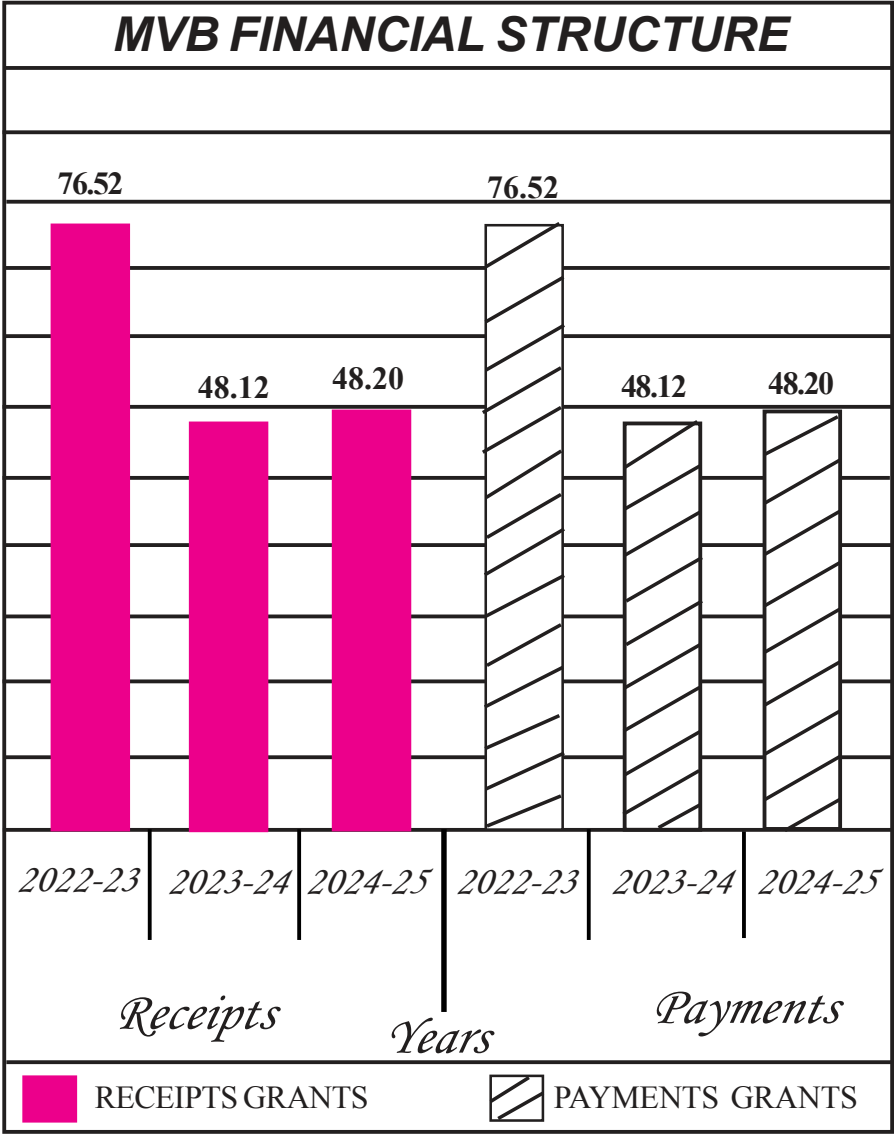
